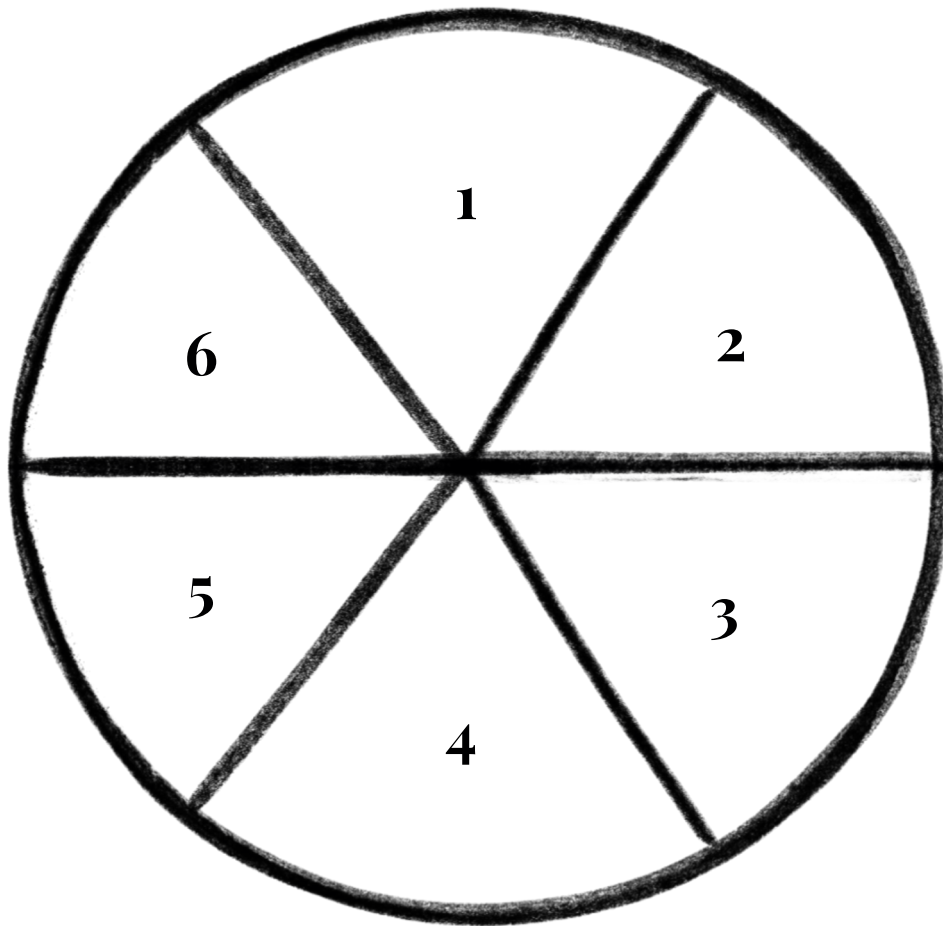
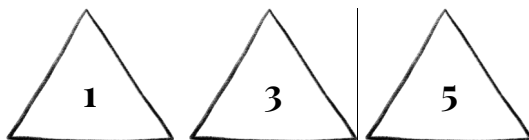


COLORING A COLOR WHEEL

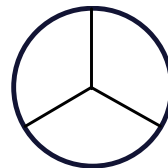

COLORS**



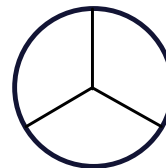
They are made

COLORS**



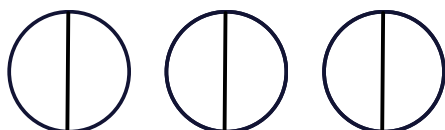
They make

COLORS**



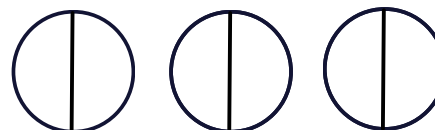
They make
